1. SHARE CAPITAL

It will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to be held on 17 May 2019 an ordinary resolution to grant the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors up to 10% of the Shares in issue as at the date of the passing of such resolution.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the authorized share capital of the Company was HK\$200,000,000 divided into 20,000,000,000 Shares, of which 7,748,960,899 Shares were in issue. On such basis (and assuming no further Shares are issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the Annual General Meeting), the Directors would be authorized to repurchase up to 774,896,089 Shares.

2. REASONS FOR THE REPURCHASE

- (2) A member entitled to attend and vote at the meeting is entitled to appoint one or more proxies to attend and, in the event of a poll, vote in his stead. A proxy need not be a member of the Company.
- (3) To be valid, the form of proxy, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of such power of attorney or authority, must be deposited with (i) the Company's head office and principal place of business in Hong Kong at 15th Floor of Tower II, Admiralty Centre, No. 18 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong if you are Shareholders in Hong Kong; or (ii) the office of the Company's share transfer agent in Singapore, Boardroom Corporate & Advisory Services Pte. (formerly known as Lim Associates (Pte) Ltd) at 50 Raffles Place, #32-01 Singapore Land Tower, Singapore 048623 if you are Shareholders in Singapore, as soon as possible but in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the meeting or any adjourned meeting (as the case may be).
- (4) Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude members from attending and voting in person at the meeting or any adjourned meeting should they so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to have been revoked.
